Map Information

During the night between 25 and 26 November 2022, a cyclone centred over Italy brought heavy rains to central and southern Italy, particularly over the Campania region. The heavy rains triggered a huge mudflow on the mountainside near Casamicciola hamlet on the island of Ischia, just off the coast of Campania. At least ten houses were destroyed and several roads were interrupted by the landslide.

The present map shows the landslide in the area of Casamicciola (Italy). The thematic layer has been derived from post-event satellite image by means of visual interpretation. The scale of analysis is 1:10000. The estimated geometric accuracy (RMSE) is 3m or better, from native positional accuracy of the background satellite image. The minimum mapping unit (MMU) is 225 sqm.
